

Step-by-Step Guide for the All Digital version of the Barton Reading & Spelling System

Step #1: Download the Barton Tiles App

From an **iPad**, go to:

When you open the Barton Tiles app, enter the username and password that were sent to you as a separate email.

You do NOT have to buy the levels. They are preloaded into the App.

So go ahead and set up your student and assign the student to a lesson.


Step #2: Watch the Tutor Training Video

To change the size of the page:

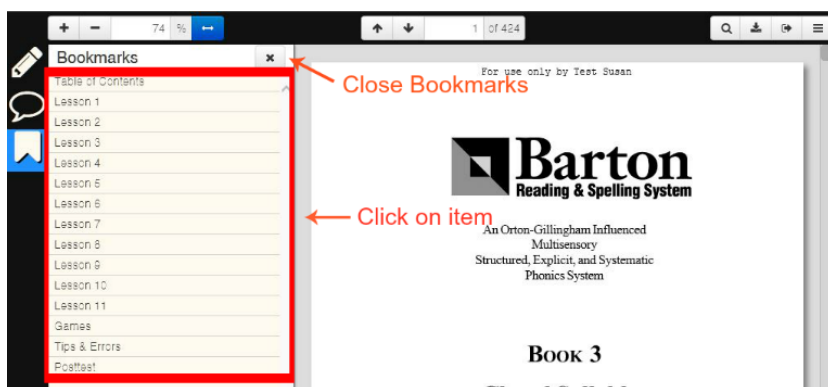


To jump to a Lesson or the Table of Contents:

Click on the **Bookmark** tool.



Click on a Lesson or the Table of Contents, then close the Bookmarks palette.



To highlight text in the manual:

Click on the **Highlighter** tool.

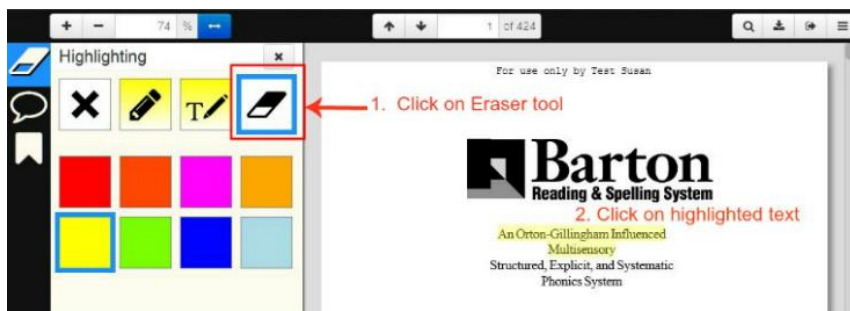


Click on the **Text** tool, click on the **color**, then **drag across** text on the page.



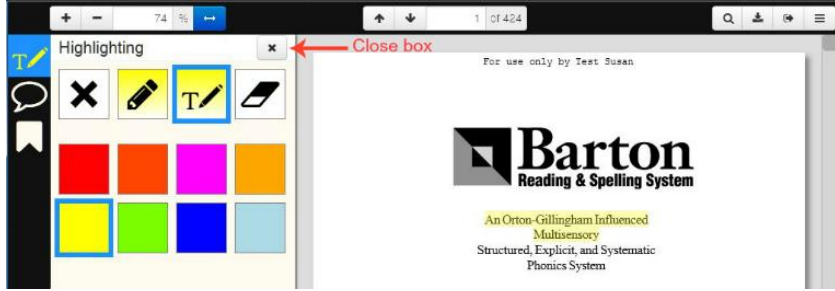
To get rid of highlighting:

Click on the **Eraser** tool, click on the **highlighting** on the page.



To close the highlighting palette:

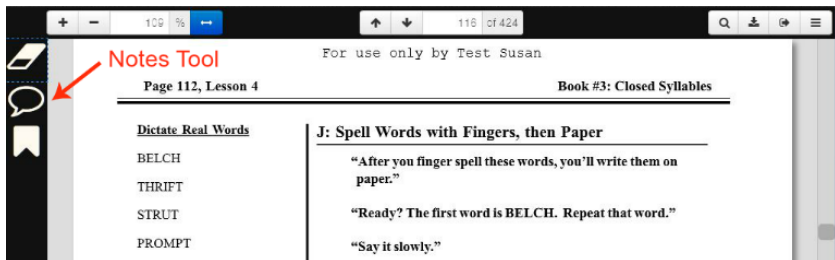
Click on the **Close** box.



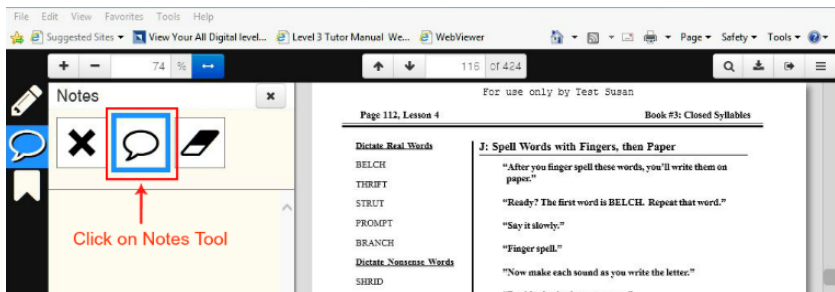
To insert a note:

Notes are used when you have several students in the same level. Insert a note where students left off at the end of a session.

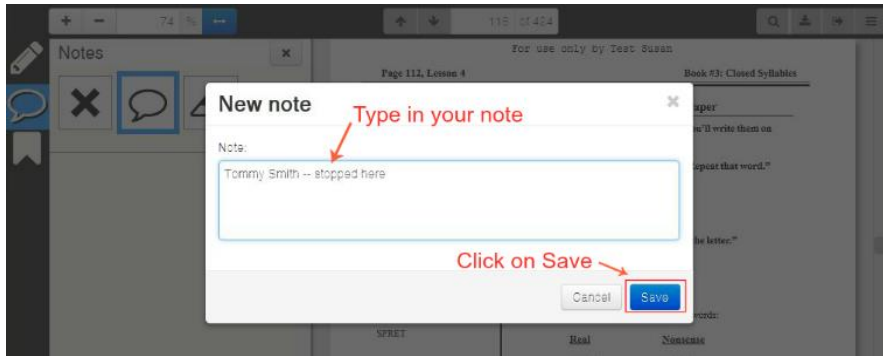
Click on the **Notes** tool.



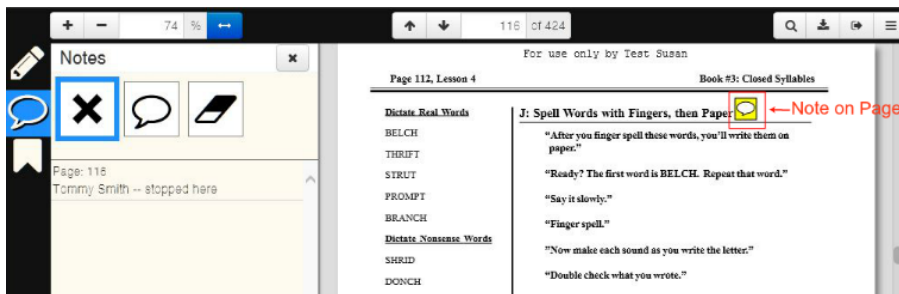
Click on the **Notes** tool in the Notes palette.



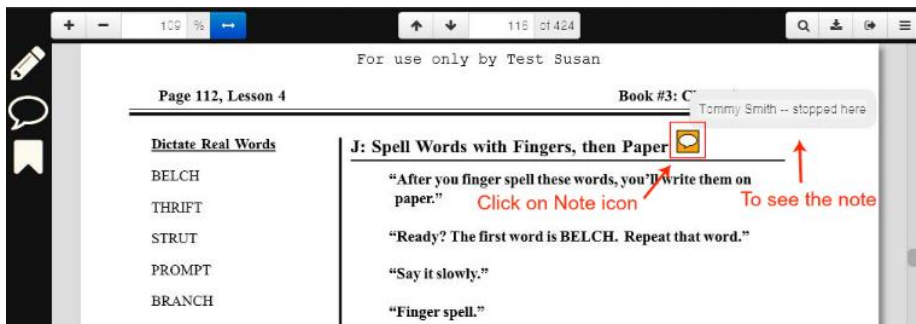
Click on the page on the **manual**, type in the note, click on Save .



On the page in the Tutor Manual, your note will look like this:

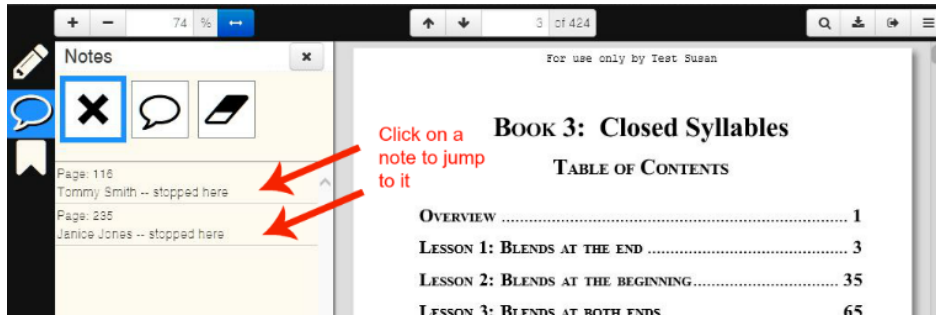


Click on any yellow note icon to read its note.



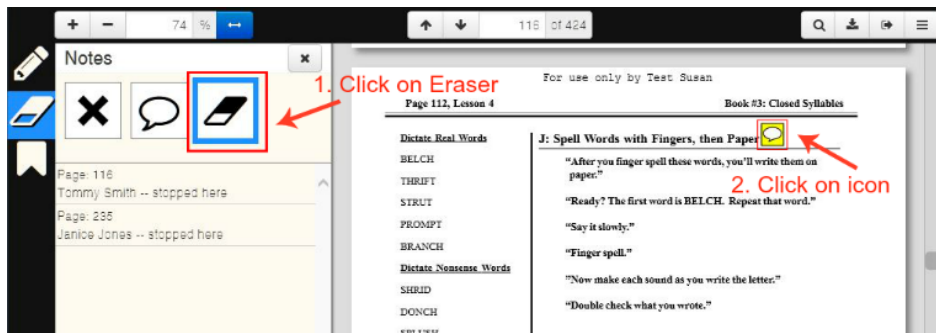
To jump to a note:

Open the **Notes** palette, click on the **Note on the list** on the palette.

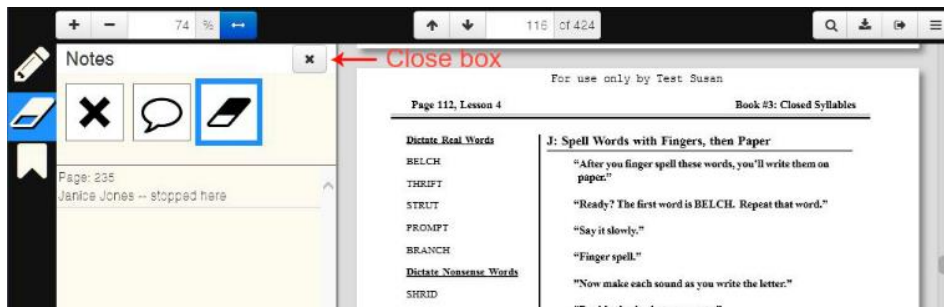


To erase a note:

Jump to a note, click on the **Eraser** tool, click on the **icon** on the page.



Close the Notes palette.

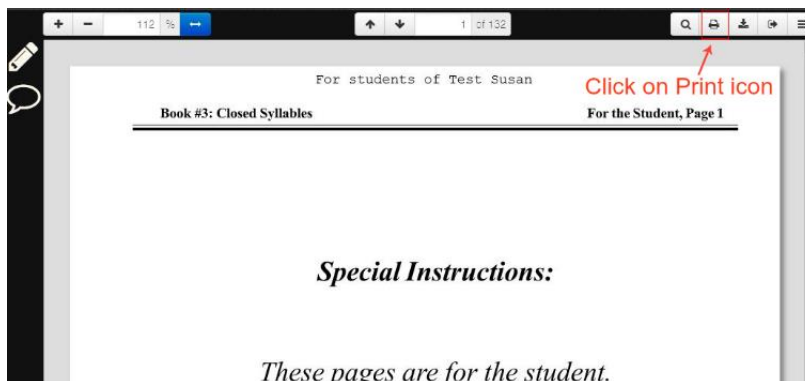


To Print Student Pages:

Click on the **Student Pages** link to open them.

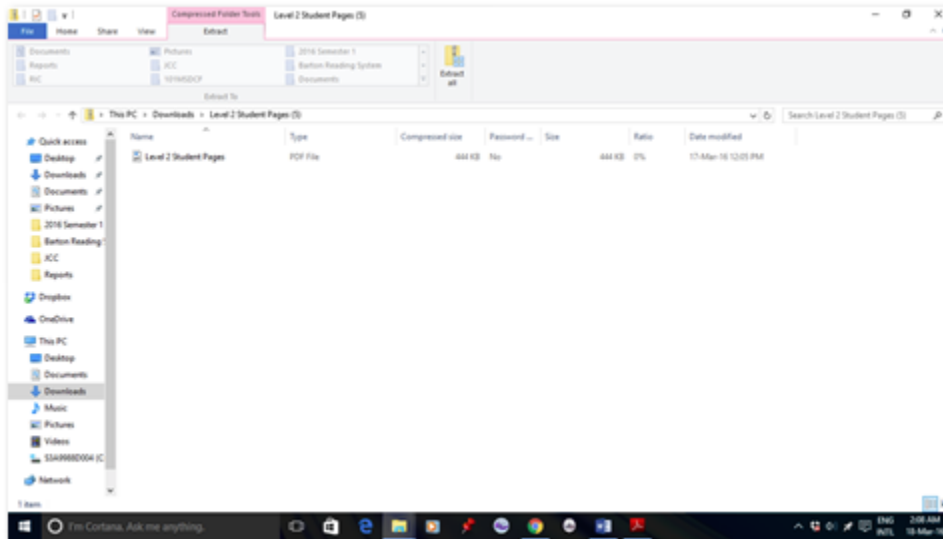

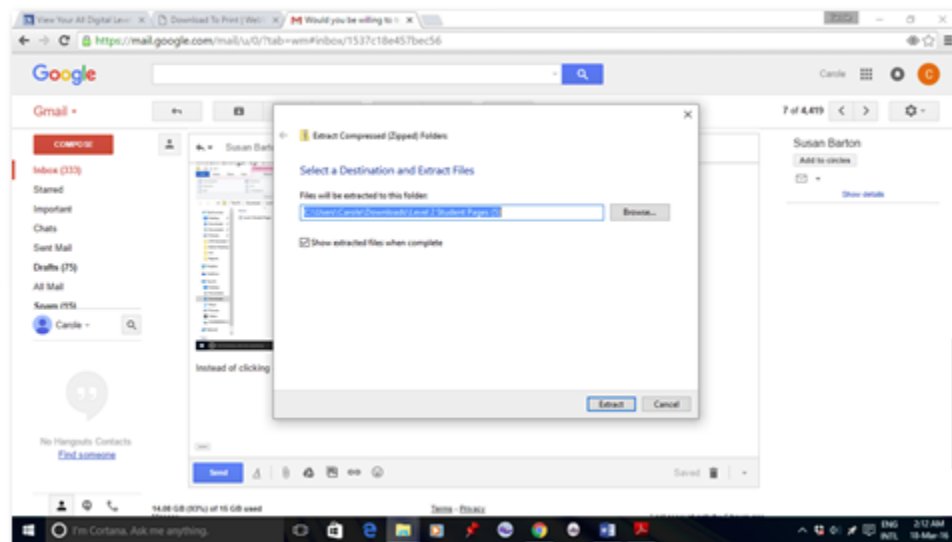
Click on this → [Download to print](#)

Open that file in **Adobe Acrobat**. If asked, allow it to check the network. You have 30 minutes to print it.

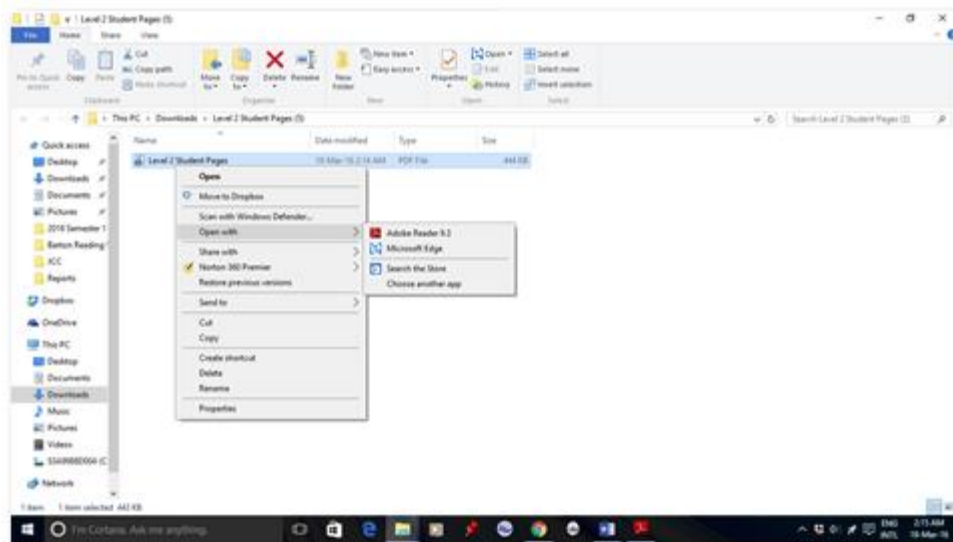
If your computer tries to open it in a Browser, it will bring up this screen:



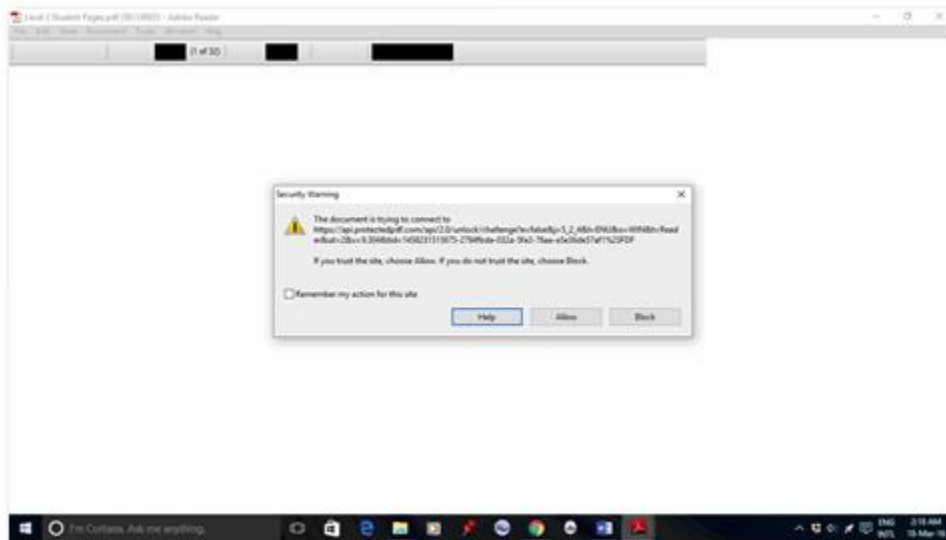
Click on Extract All. Then click on Extract. Your screen will then show this:



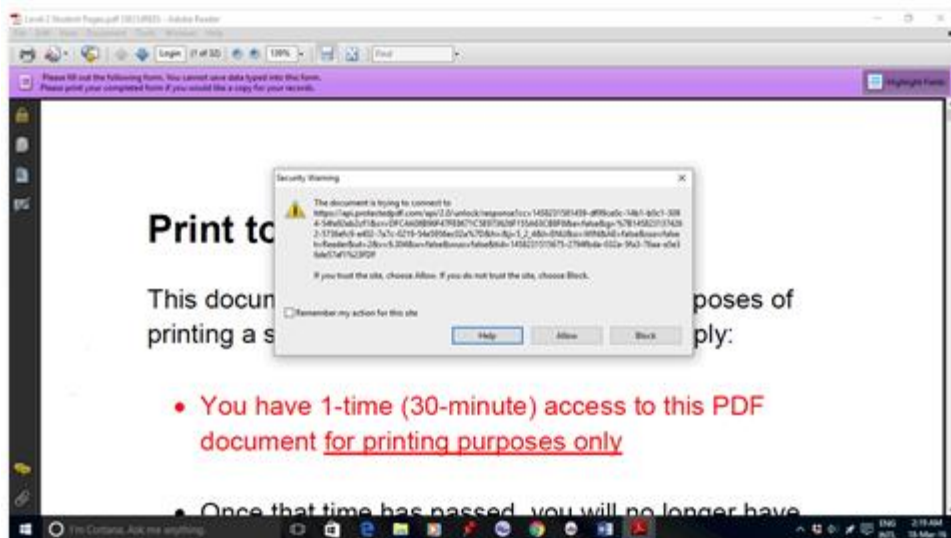
When it is done, you will see the following screen. Right-click on Open With, then choose Adobe Acrobat.



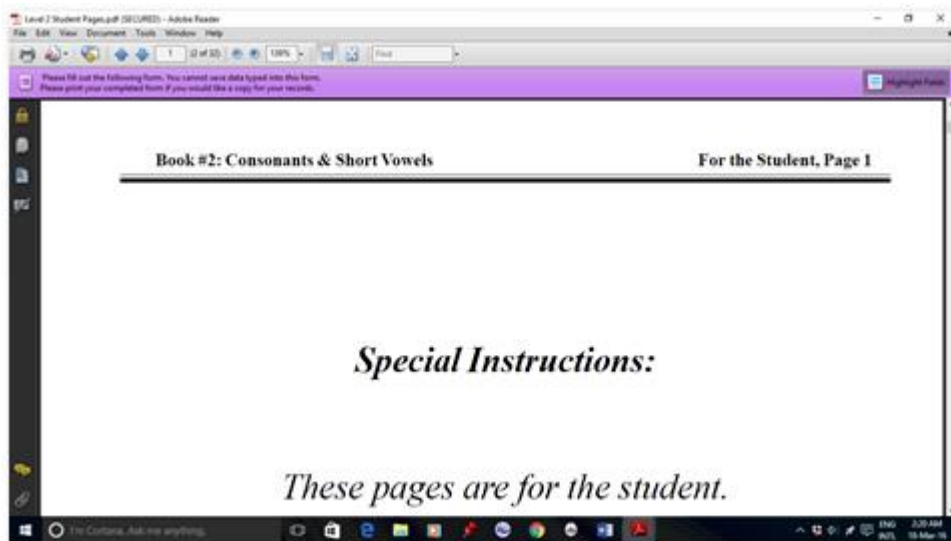
When the following screen appears, click on Allow.



And when the following screen appears, click on Allow.



Adobe Acrobat should now be open with the first page of our student pages showing, like this:



You can now choose File . . . Print.
